Dear Colleagues,

It has been more than 30 years when World Institute of Pain has been established in 1993. During these more than 3 decades, WIP has organized 12 World Congresses, established 27 sections from all over the world, with the Pain Practice Journal since 2001. Board of Examination established in 2001 and since 2001, a total of 1,709 physicians have been certified FIPP representing 69 countries, since 2010, a total of 497 physicians have been certified CIPS representing 53 countries.

WIP has 24 Centers of Excellence/EPP in 12 countries.

WIP organizes SWEs (Symposium, Workshop, Examination) in;

- Budapest, Hungary since 1996,
- Miami, Orlando, Florida, USA since 2012,
- Istanbul, Turkey, since 2018 and
- San Paulo, Brazil, 2026

The mission of WIP is to educate and train our colleagues by including local hands-on training, international seminars and exchange of clinicians all over the world.

Turkish Registered Section of World Institute of Pain established in June 2018 has organized 8 international and 6 national meetings since then.

Between 28-30 October 2023, on the 100th Anniversary of the Declaration of the Turkish Republic as well as the 30th anniversary of the establishment of WIP, 12th World Congress of WIP was organized in Antalya with more than 700 participants from 58 countries for the Congress, as well as the 6th Symposium and Cadaver Workshop with a total number of 80 FIPP/CIPS Participants and 91 examinees for FIPP-CIPS examination.

Between 17-20 October 2024, 7th Interventional Pain Istanbul Congress and Cadaver Workshop was organized in Istanbul, Turkey with 215 participants from 30 countries and the FIPP/CIPS examination was held with 95 examinees, with the highest number of all times in WIP history at that time.

Between 16-19 October 2025, 8th Interventional Pain Istanbul Congress and Cadaver Workshop was organized in Istanbul, with 185 participants from 28 different countries.

the FIPP/CIPS examination was held with 102 examinees, with the highest number of all times in WIP history at Istanbul has now the seal in WIP history for today and future.

The facilities we have in CASE Laboratories of Acibadem University are outstanding for the cadaver course and symposium as well as the examination.

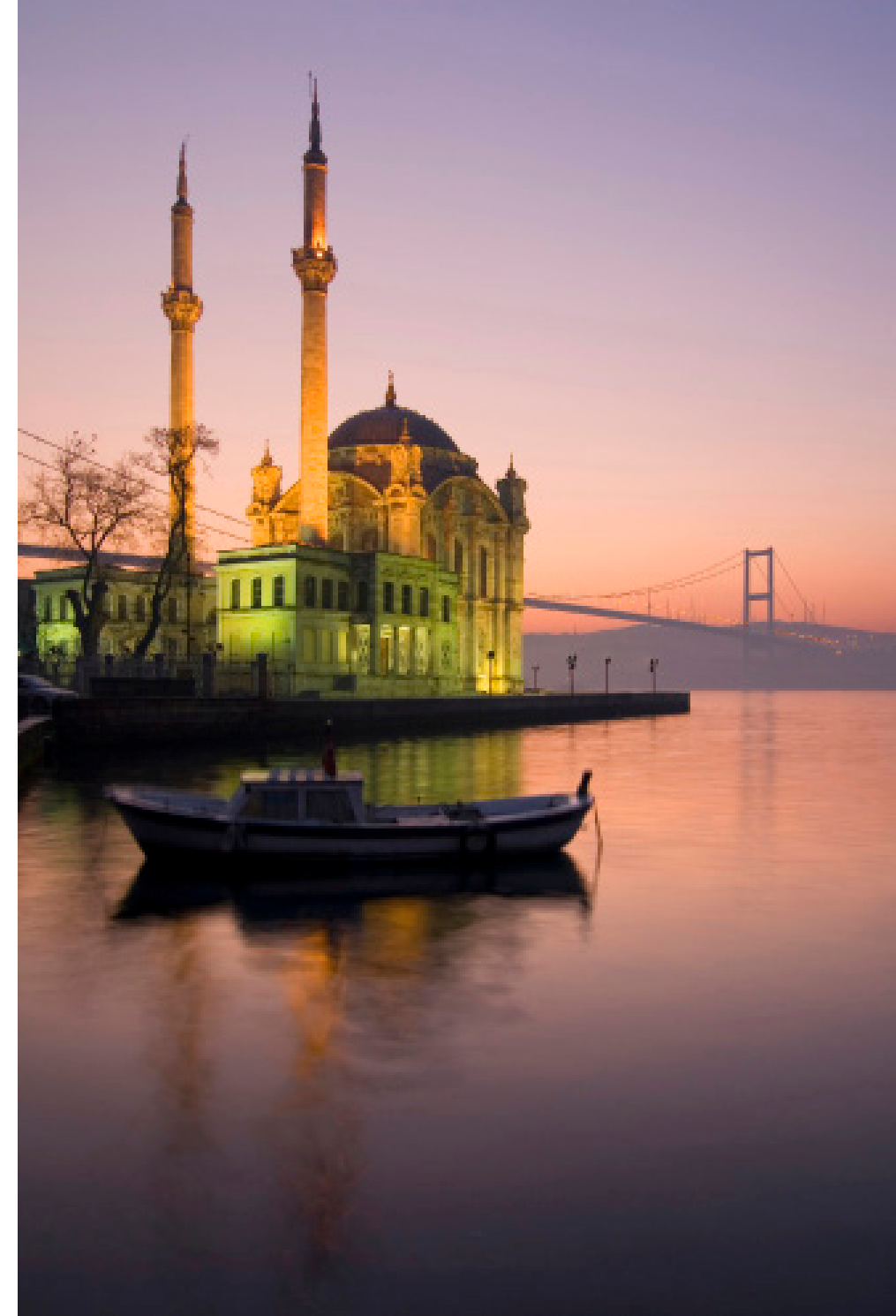
GENERAL INFORMATION

MISSION STATEMENT

The majority of acute, chronic, and cancer patients are inadequately represented in the world. The population of chronic pain and cancer pain patients is expected to double by the year 2030, and the older population is expected to live longer. Specialized and focused care of pain patients is essential if adequate and continued care is to provide comfort and functional improvement in their daily living. Pain medicine specialists can provide this care. Through educational initiatives, including WIP World Congresses, regional symposia, and practical workshops on interventional pain practice, WIP helps promote consensus building among experts on the effectiveness of existing techniques and avenues for advancement of therapeutic performances.

GOALS

- To educate and train personnel of member pain centers by including local hands-on training, international seminars, and exchange of clinicians. Update pain centers with state-of-the-art pain information, including a newsletter, scientific seminars, interlined telecommunications, and publication of a journal and books.
- Develop common protocols for efficacy and outcome studies.
- Communicate administrative and patient-related matters on a regular basis by way of newsletter, telephone hook-up, world directory of pain centers by region, and video conferencing (including patient consultation).
- Categorize and credential pain centers by mail correspondence, local information, and the industry's medical representatives.
- Develop examination process for pain centers in testing trainees and provide know-how in the examination process.
- Encourage interested industries to provide information on pain medicine in each region of the world; to bring together local pain physicians and industry for education in new technology and training; and to formulate a fellowship-training program.

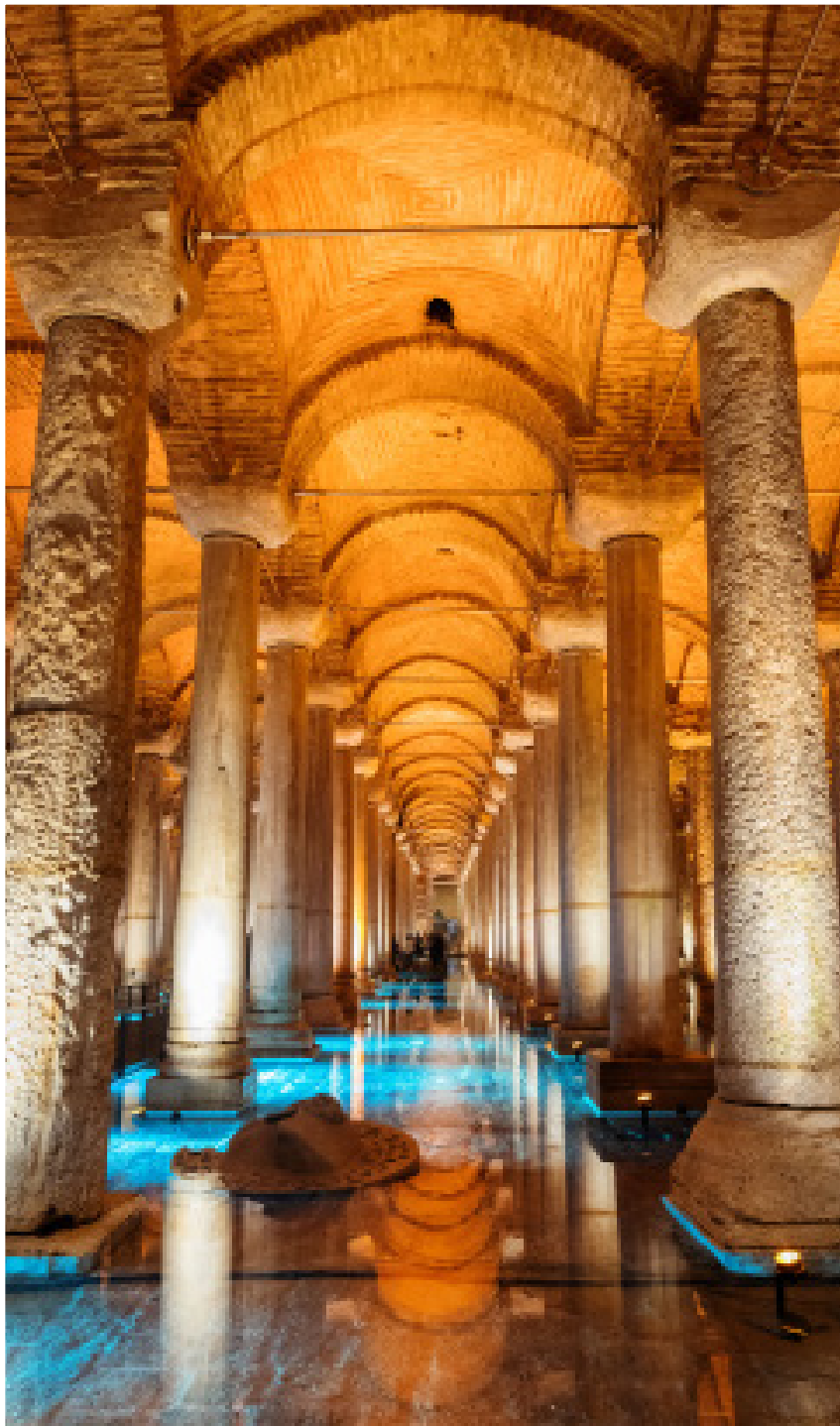
WIP recognizes the value of formal liaisons with other scientific and professional organizations whose purposes are consistent with the mission and aims of WIP.
